Groups of girls led by volunteers who participate in the Girl Scout Leadership Experience.


Juliettes



Registration Information

Now that you've registered...

- On your confirmation page, you can choose "Manage My Account" to take you to your "My GS" account.
- Click on "My Events" tab in the left panel to see a list of all your events.
- Click on the event to see more details about the event including:
- 1. List of attendees
- 2. Location of events
- 3. Cancellation policies

FAQ's

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: How do I see what events I'm registered for?

A: Log into your MyGS account and click on "My Events" on the left panel to see the events for which you are registered. If you registered your Troop, this will show as well. You can click on each event to see more details.

Q: How can I see if I have any balance owed for events?

A: Log into your My GS account and click on "My Events" on the left panel to see the events for which you are registered. Click into each event and you will see any that have a balance owed.

Q: Can I change the dietary restrictions or other special information that was requested on the event registration?

A: Please be sure you have all the correct information needed for each girl before you register, as you cannot make any changes after registration has been completed. This includes dietary information, buddies requests, other special circumstances or information for the event. Please reach out to customerservice@girlscoutnv.org for assistance in making changes.

Cancellations

If an event is cancelled, the person listed on the registration form as the Troop or parent contact will be notified by phone or email. For Troop registrations, it will be the responsibility of the Troop contact person to notify all girls registered for the event. Cancellations initiated by the Council or program partner will result in full refund of fees paid.

Registration Deadlines

Please be mindful of event registration deadlines! Early registration in encouraged, as many events fill up quickly. Fees may increase past the registration deadline or spots may not be available.

Fees

Event fees are charged to cover the costs of events and are due at the time of registration. Fees can be paid through Troop funds, individually, or with program credits.

Event Etiquette

Please arrive to events and activities with enough time to check-in before the program starts. Be sure to dress appropriately for the activity and weather. Always wear your uniform whenever appropriate.

Let girls take the lead! While adults should be nearby to supervise, allow girls to do activities with minimal adult intervention.

Be sure to thank your event leaders for sharing their time and skills with you! Older girls and volunteers may be needed to assist with events and activities, please let the organizer know you're available to help.

Register for an Event

- Once you find an event, choose Event Details to review details about the event.
- Please read everything in the Event Details section before you begin the registration process.
- Use the "+" symbol to select the number of girls and/or adults that you are registering for this event in the right-side panel.
- Scroll down and select the green "Log-In" or "Add Events" button. You will be prompted to sign in or create an account if you don't currently have a My GS account.
- On the next page, under "Assign Attendees," select either "My Household" or "My Troop Member" (if you are a Troop Leader registering troop girls)
- 1. Choose your first attendee.
- Choose payment option for the attendee. You may have to choose a payment option even if the event is free.
- 3. Click Next Participant and repeat the process until all attendees are added.
- 4. Once all attendees have been added, choose Submit Member Details.
- Review that the total amount is correct on the right panel.
- Register for additional events? To register for another event in this transaction, click on the "Girl Scout Logo."
- Please consider making a donation to Girl Scouts of Southern Nevada to provide financial assistance and help support our council programs.
- Accept the Girl Scout Promise and Law at the bottom of the right panel (this must be checked in order to move on.)
- · Click Add Payment Details.
- · Add payment information and click "Submit Payment."
- You will see a payment confirmation showing the order number and the email address where the receipt will be sent You may also Print Receipt if needed for troop financial reporting purposes.



Girl Scout adult volunteer trainings are designed to accommodate various training preferences and schedules. We offer a flexible approach to learning, with options including in-person sessions, virtual trainings and our innovative on-demand training platform, gsLearn, which allows you to access training materials at your own pace and convenience.

This year, Girl Scouts is expanding its training offerings to include additional opportunities for learning and growth; including age-level training, international travel training, updated High Awards trainings, Girl Scouts Songbook and more.

Please note that required trainings are effective for a period of three years before requiring renewal.

Finance 101

Beyond the Basics (camping).

CPR/First Aid training is typically offered monthly, and recertification is required every 2 years. At least one volunteer who is CPR/First Aid certified must be present when working with girls.

Take Action

- 1. Create a "happy box" filled with five things that make you smile, such as photos, art supplies, books, or favorite toys. Open the box when you're worried, upset, or just need a little cheering up.

 Learn more.
- 1. Share stories with your friends about your favorite holiday, your greatest adventure, or your dreams for the future! They will learn more about you and you'll learn more about them.
- 1. Design a coaching plan for your team by developing creative warmup and cool-down routines, using the best stretches and exercises to encourage your troop to stay active!
- 1. Select and carry out a national Girl Scout service project to support your community. Pick your favorite.
- **1.** Visit a garden in your commuity or your own backyard to get ideas for creating a garden of your own.
- 1. Put up a bird feeder, plant flowers to attract hummingbirds, or get outside to watch and listen to our feathered friends.
- 1. Find an outdoor scene it might be a lake, creek, trail, or your own backyard. Draw, film, or photograph the scene several times during the day or on different days. Observe how eather and time of day change the scene's appearance.
- 1. Create a keepsake a painting, collage song, poem, scrapbook, bookmark, piece of jewelry, or another object that reminds you of your favorite line from the Girl Scout Law. Learn More
- 1. Music brings people together, and when people come together, they can build community. Make up a song about something you care about (friends, family, a favorite animal, etc.) Record your song and share it with others or sing it at an event.
- 1. Plant a tree to support the Girl Scout Tree Promise, and join a global movement to address climate change, one tree at a time. Learn more.

- 2. Learn how to use mental imagery to prepare for your next hike, run, or sports activity. Mental imagery can improve your performance and build your self-confidence.

 Learn more.
- **2.** Create a family crest to tell the story of your family's heritage, values, or memorable moments. Or design a rest for any group you belong to, such as a school club, athletic team, or your Girl Scout troop. **Learn more**.
- **2.** Create a new dance move for your favorite song. Dance to the beat every day for a week or throw a dance party and teach it to friends.
- 2. Start a gratitude journal: jot down two or three things you're thankful for and three to five things that make you happy. (They could be one and the same!) Do this every day for one to two weeks. When you're done, record how the practice made you feel. Learn more.
- **2.** Go on a night sky scavenger hunt: identify stars, constellations, or planets. Use a book, star wheel, or an app to chart your way.
- 2. Find out what it's like to have a career protecting animals by talking to a veterinarian, animal-rescue worker, or zookeeper. Learn More.
- 2. Sketch a still life three times, using a different medium (colored pencils, regular pencils, charcoal, ink pen, markers, pastels, crayons) each time. Learn more.
- **2.** Every job offers different ways for you to help others. Choose two or three jobs that interest you and find out how they might add meaning to yours and others' lives. Interview people in your community, watch videos, or read articles about these jobs.
- **2.** You belong to a community of girls worldwide. Create a girls' Bill of Rights that includes at least five things you think girls should have the right to do. *Learn more*.
- 2. Learn the difference between community service and the Girl Scout concept of Take Action, then brainstorm some ways to engage in the latter! Girl Scout Junior of older? Start planning your Bronze, Silver, and Gold Award.


Join us at one of our most popular events of the year - The Cookie Rally! We welcome you, your family and friends for a magical day filled with fun, food and cookie program information.

Our 2024 Cookie mascot is the Axolotl and the theme is Own Your Magic.














Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Program Series





Is your troop not participating or are you not in a troop?

Girls whose troop is not participating or who are not in a troop can participate in product programs the same ways listed above. Individual girls will earn Program Points that can be used to purchase membership and pay for camp, event fees, destinations (travel trips for girls ages 11 and older), or items in the Girl Scout store.
