Ready to lead, shine, and make camp magic happen? This Cadette Program Aide camp is designed to help girls build strong leadership skills while supporting younger campers as they explore, learn, and have fun. The program follows the **new GSUSA Program Aide requirements**, and Cadettes who successfully complete the week will **earn the Program Aide pin** at the end of camp.

Program Aides receive hands-on training to guide activities, assist with badges, mentor younger girls, and work as part of a team—building confidence, communication, and résumé-ready skills along the way. Campers will also plan and lead an exciting all-camp activity, putting their creativity and leadership into action.

Cadettes who complete the program will have the opportunity to **volunteer at Camp Ducktail Day Camp at no additional cost**, earning service hours that count toward their **Girl Scout Service in Girl Scouting pin**.

Ready to take your leadership to the next level? This **2-week Counselor-in-Training (CIT) Program** is designed for Senior and Ambassador Girl Scouts who are ready to grow into confident camp leaders. The program follows **GSUSA's new CIT I and CIT II requirements**, and girls who successfully complete the full two weeks will **earn their CIT I or CIT II pin**.

CITs gain hands-on experience by assisting camp staff, leading activities, mentoring younger campers, and completing service projects—all while building teamwork, problem-solving, leadership, and career-readiness skills. This immersive experience helps girls grow confidence and prepares them for future roles as camp counselors and leaders.

Girls who complete the program will also have the opportunity to **volunteer as a counselor at Camp Ducktail Day Camp at no additional cost**, earning service hours that count toward the **Girl Scout Service in Girl Scouting pin**.

*Note: Girls registering for CIT II must have successfully completed CIT I prior to attending this program.*

## Camp Fees & Refunds

### DEPOSITS & FEES

- A non-refundable \$50 deposit per session is due at registration and counts toward the total camp fee.
- Deposits must be paid through the registration system.
- Remaining fees are due two weeks before the session start date.
- Registration closes three weeks prior to the session start date.

### MEMBERSHIP

- Not a member? Join for \$45 (applies only to new members; current Girl Scouts are exempt).
- Membership fees (\$25 Girl Scout + \$15 GSSNV Council Service) are non-refundable.

### CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY

- Girl Scouts of Southern Nevada may cancel or change activities due to low enrollment, severe weather, or natural disasters.
- For camp cancellations, a full refund minus the \$50 deposit is available if requested three weeks before the session start date.
- Refunds require a written request (email or letter) to [customerservice@girlscoutsnv.org](mailto:customerservice@girlscoutsnv.org), including the member's name, address, program name, date, and reason.
- No refunds for no-shows, partial-week attendance, or transfers between members.
- Refunds with 30+ days' notice from the registration close date may be considered.
