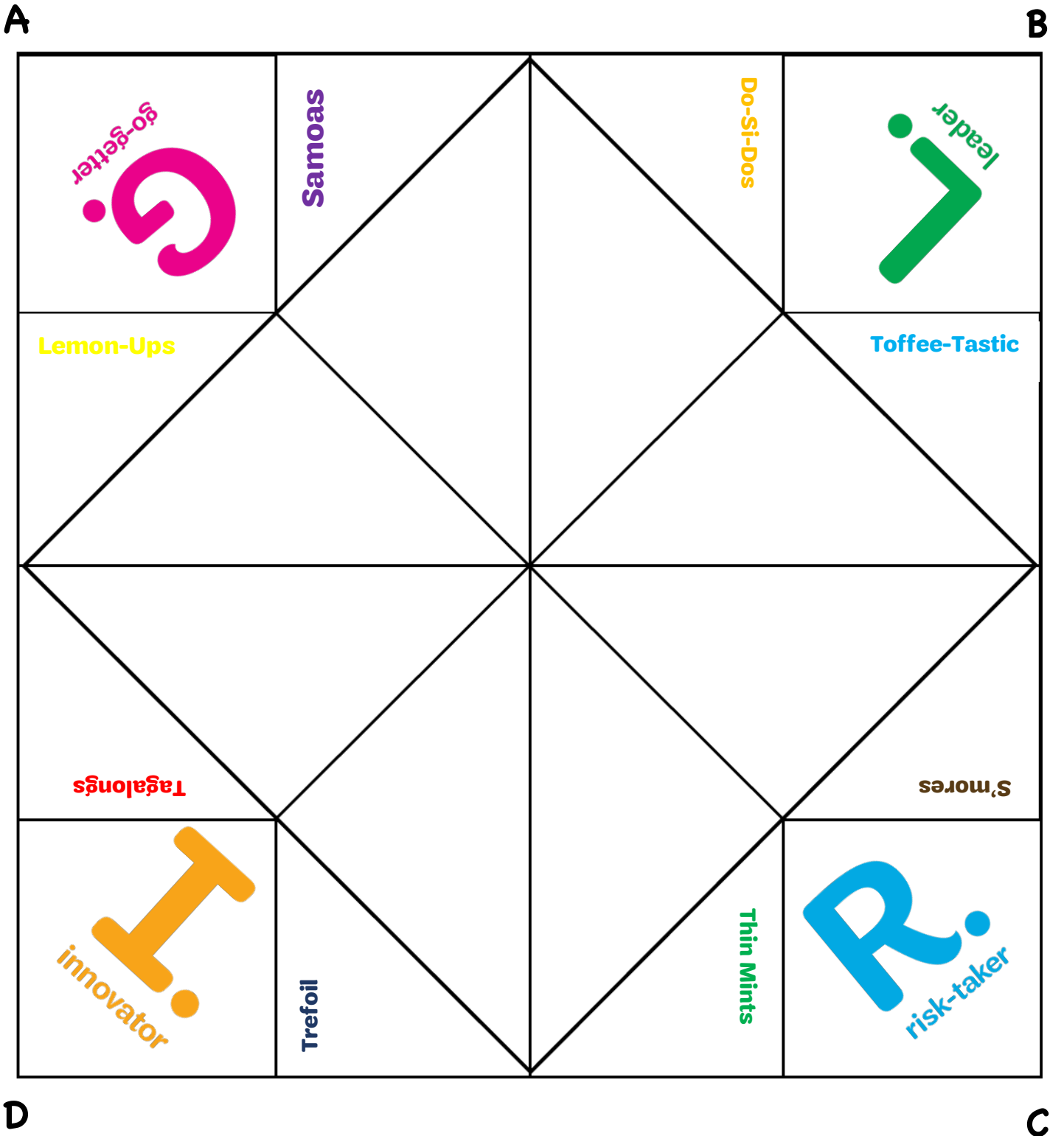


G.I.R.L. FORTUNE TELLER

How to fold a paper fortune teller:

1. In the empty center triangle spaces, write down different fortunes that could happen to someone while Girl Scouting
 - a. *Example: You'll become an amazing troop leader in the future, you'll go on a long but fun outdoor adventure and learn something new, you'll meet your cookie goal next season, etc*
2. Using scissors, cut along the outer borderline from A to B to C to D.
3. Flip your paper so the back is facing up
4. Fold from corner to corner making a triangle
5. Open the paper (back facing up again) and fold from corner to corner in the opposite direction. Unfold your paper. You should have a giant X creased into it
6. Fold one corner into the center of the square where the two diagonals meet (the center of the X crease). Repeat this with the other three corners. Your square will be smaller now.
7. Flip your paper over and fold from the corner to the center of the square where the two diagonals meet (just like in step 6). Repeat this with the rest of the corners. Your square will be even smaller now.
8. Fold and unfold your square in half horizontally and vertically.
9. Turn your paper over and slide your fingers under the flaps and push the outer corners to the middle.
10. All done! Now enjoy your fortune teller and have fun!
